



We are proud to be an Operation Encompass supported school.

Operation Encompass directly connects the police with schools, to ensure support for children living with domestic abuse in their homes and when there has been a Police attended incident of Domestic Abuse. Rapid provision of support within the school environment means children are better safeguarded against the short-, medium- and long-term effects of domestic abuse.

Prior to the child arriving in school, the Key Adult (DSL) will receive a simple phone call or notification from the Police. The call or notification is triggered by police recently attending the child's home or being involved in a domestic abuse incident, that the child has experienced.

This early notification allows schools to be able to offer immediate support to children and young people experiencing domestic abuse, dependent on the needs and wishes of the child.

Teachers will be informed of any notifications from Operation Encompass prior to the arrival of the child at school.
